

# GeoMôn – Anglesey UNESCO Geopark

**MEMBERS' WALK – Sat 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019 – Newborough & Llanddwyn**



**Start time** 11.00am

**Meeting place** By the toilet block in Newborough Beach car park

**Duration** Between 3½ and 4 hours

## Where will we be walking to?

Through the forest, then the beach followed by walking to the Pilot Houses and far end of the island.

## What are the geological highlights?

We will see a complete mini tectonic plate. Stop 1 - the geotrail in the forest to see the ancient sea bed and altered pillow lavas. Stop 2 - to see the pillow lavas, jasper and epidote on the beach followed by the exploded volcanic material by the entrance to the island. Stop 3 – a snack lunch at the Pilot Cottages then on to the western end of the island to see the colourful melange and dyke in Porth Twr Bach. Return along the beach to the car park.

## Lunch arrangements

A snack will be provided when we reach the Pilot Cottages on Llanddwyn Island.

## Gear

Sensible footwear and wet weather gear if necessary.

## Charge

The walk is free for members and includes lunch. Non-members are welcome and a small charge of £5 is payable at the start of the walk, which includes the lunchtime snacks.
